Garth Winckler leads the WorldDoc Charitable, Education and Research Foundation. Winckler has consulting experience in the areas of organizational development, community organization, and community affairs services for both non-profit organizations and corporations. Prior to joining WorldDoc's management team, Winckler was a President of Garth Winckler and Associates, providing consulting services for clients including: the Clark County Health Access Consortium, VisionLink, Inc., Nevada Public Radio, Henderson Area Community Advocates, Easter Seals of Nevada, Aid for AIDS of Nevada (AFAN), and WorldDoc, Inc. For nearly 27 years, Winckler served in staff leadership positions for United Ways in OH and NV, spending 16 years as the President and Chief Professional Officer of the United Way of Southern Nevada.

Winckler has been an instructor in the UNLV Continuing Education Division - Certificate in Non-Profit Management Program, teaching courses in strategic planning and leading the non-profit organization. He is a member of the Nevada Community Foundation Board, the UNLV Greenspun College of Urban Affairs Community Advisory Board, and Past-President of the Board for the Las Vegas chapter of Community in Schools.

He has an undergraduate degree (BS) from the University of Wisconsin – Oshkosh (1968), a Masters in Urban Affairs from the University of New Hampshire (1972), a Masters of Public Administration from UNLV (1979), and a certificate in Non-Profit Management from the Harvard School of Business (1982).
